PLEASE READ CAREFULLY -- NEW RULES --

Set up/Take Down

- You must be there at <u>7:45</u> to set up your chairs, tables, and pop up tents (Bring your own)
- You must also help take down and store everything at the end of each bake sale event (even if you leave early, you must return to help)
- All trash in front of the church lawn and plaza from the bake sale must be picked up and discarded.

Conduct

- You MUST attend one of the masses. Sitting at a bake sale does not qualify as attending mass!!!
- You are not allowed to use your phones to play secular music No headphones. Get to know one another!
- **DRESS CODE**: Casual modest clothing. No (Athletic attire) leggings or shorts shorts, tank tops or mid drifts.

Baked Goods

- Must be homemade (NO STORE BOUGHT GOODS)
- All goods must be packaged and priced for distribution
- You must supply your own bags and wrappers
- NO OPEN AIR GOODS! All items must be covered from the elements

Table/Display/Money Handling

- You must provide your own tablecloth, forks, spoons, cups, etc
- Price sheet and tape
- BRING Change for \$\$\$ and cash box or envelope
- All Checks made to St. Anne's Youth Ministries
- YOU MUST TURN IN ALL RECEIPTS FOR SUPPLIES USED FOR THE BAKE SALE
- At the end of the sale all money collected will be deposited. You must also submit receipts for reimbursement. <u>ALL MONEY COLLECTED ON CHURCH</u>
 <u>PROPERTY MUST BE COUNTED AND DEPOSITED IMMEDIATELY.</u>

 STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO TAKE HOME MONEY
